#### **Scripture References**

Expect More – Week 2 "Expect Synergy"

Read and reflect on the following scriptures.

#### Acts 9:26-28

<sup>26</sup> When Paul came to Jerusalem, he tried to join the disciples, but they were all afraid of him, not believing that he really was a disciple. <sup>27</sup> But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles. He told them how Saul on his journey had seen the Lord and that the Lord had spoken to him, and how in Damascus he had preached fearlessly in the name of Jesus. <sup>28</sup> So Saul stayed with them and moved about freely in Jerusalem, speaking boldly in the name of the Lord. <sup>29</sup> He talked and debated with the Hellenistic Jews,<sup>[a]</sup> but they tried to kill him. <sup>30</sup>When the believers learned of this, they took him down to Caesarea and sent him off to Tarsus.

#### Acts 15:36-40

<sup>36</sup> Some time later Paul said to Barnabas, "Let us go back and visit the believers in all the towns where we preached the word of the Lord and see how they are doing." <sup>37</sup> Barnabas wanted to take John, also called Mark, with them, <sup>38</sup> but Paul did not think it wise to take him, because he had deserted them in Pamphylia and had not continued with them in the work. <sup>39</sup> They had such a sharp disagreement that they parted company. Barnabas took Mark and sailed for Cyprus, <sup>40</sup> but Paul chose Silas and left, commended by the believers to the grace of the Lord.

This sermon is based on studies Pastor Neal has been doing on understanding God's direction in our lives. He has developed a seminar to help us become the kind of people who know what nest steps to take and are willing and able to take those steps and make those changes. - 2. How does that change the way you think about synergy in relationships?
- 3. Have you experienced synergy from a relationship?
- 4. Why might a "Holy Spirit Welcoming Situation" need to include people outside of the church?
