Frequently CAsked Questions

What is the time commitment?

Meeting times are flexible - typically once or twice a month initially lasting for about 6 months.

We have small children and do not have childcare. Is that a problem?

No, the meetings can take place in a kid-friendly location, in the Mentorees' home, or in a reserved room during a second church service when there is childcare.

Do you offer marriage counseling?

What happens after we sign up?
