





March Field Air Museum


Saturday, October 20 | Riverside

Travel with Savvy Travelers for a visit to the March Field Air Museum in Riverside, which displays nearly 80 historic Army Air Corps, Air Force and Navy aircraft spanning 100 years of aviation history. The outdoor collection includes World War I biplanes, War II bombers and cargo planes, helicopters of the Viet-

nam period and the jet fighters and "supersize" and "superspeed" planes of today, and even a few "bad guys" - Russian MIGs. Inside the main building are numerous exhibits of aircraft details and equipment, flyers' uniforms and gear, military drones and special "outer space" subjects. All the aircraft and exhibits can be seen "up close and personal" and docents - mostly former flyers - will be present for information and discussions. Along with the new ministry of Life Groups, we are starting the RB Community Church College of the Bible! With Life Groups being small groups, that will primarily be held in people's homes and focus on connecting us as brothers and sisters in Christ, the College of the Bible will be focused on providing solid biblical training.

The College of the Bible is going to begin with ten tracks which students can follow that will lead to a "major," and/or "minor." When students reach a certain amount of credit hours within a track they will receive a certificate.

- 1. Christian Ministry
- 2. Biblical Studies
- 3. Theology
- 4. Christian Leadership
- 5. Missions

The Certificate Minors are:

- 1. Church Health and Growth
- 2. Spiritual Formation
- 3. Teaching
- 4. Theology and the Arts
- 5. Youth Ministry

You will still be able to take any class you like, but if you declare a major or minor, there will be a selection of courses you can take that will lead to the Certificate. If you don't declare a major or minor, you will automatically be in the Christian Ministry track.

To make your declaration, and to register in the College of the Bible, you will need to take the "Gateway Class" which will be offered various times throughout the year. You will note in the Course Catalogue that the class is offered twice this Fall Semester. You only need to attend one set of three classes.

- Wednesdays, September 26, October 3 and 10
- Wednesdays, November 28, December 5, and 12

The Gateway Class will be, in the Lower Fireside room, and will be taught by Rev. Dr. Bryan Stamper, our Senior Pastor.

If you have questions or are a bit confused as we start this new ministry, please contact me, I will be happy to talk with you. If you would like to teach a class, or know someone who could, I would love to talk with you about the possibilities.


