### **The Season of Lent: An Opportunity to Serve Others**

We started this year with Play It Forward as an outreach to children in our community and as a means of helping to teach our children the meaning of generosity. The response was AMAZING and we have delivered car loads of bikes, toys, games, books, stuffed animals, and dolls to the following agencies in San Diego: Salvation Army, Presbyterian Urban Ministries (PUM), Door of Hope, San Diego Children's Home, Support the Enlisted Project (STEP), and teddy bears to the San Diego Police Department.

These single parent families have made a commitment to be alcohol and drug free as they rebuild their lives to provide a stable home environment for their children. Part of their program requires that they eat dinner in a community setting ... parents and children together.
