WHAT'S HAPPENING AT RB COMMUNITY CHURCH

Mission Outreach Update

Each month the Ministry for Missions provides opportunities for the RB Community congregation to participate in outreach projects as a blessing to our local communities. The following is a summary of those events for the past quarter:

April

- 40 Days of Giving concluded by distributing 285 bags of gently used items for the RB Community Resale Shop, which generated an increase in proceeds to the Mission Committee
- 10 drivers picked up 2024 bags of bread from O'Brien's Boulangerie in Poway and delivered the loaves to food distribution centers in our area
- 14 backyard pickers helped others gather 387 pounds of fresh fruit for local food pantries

May

 26 people joined forces at the RB Post Office to collect and sort 35,000 pounds of canned and boxed food for local pantries

June

- 30 youth and adults helped build and paint two playhouses that were donated to families in transition at Solutions for Change and to a military family with two young daughters
- 12 Volunteers at the Habitat ReStore helped to assemble patio furniture, unload doors donated by a local contractor, measure and label windows

During the month of July we are collecting backpacks and school supplies. Last year we collected over 200 backpacks ... we hope to collect more this year. All backpacks and school supplies will be donated to Salvation Army in Escondido, some PUSD elementary and middle schools, Interfaith Community Services, and Solutions for Change. Help us help children be more successful in school by having the supplies they need.

This past week our Vacation Bible School children collected items and made up care packages on Friday, July 12 as an outreach to homeless men, women, and children served by PUM in downtown San Diego. Our youth have safely returned from their mission trip to the Dominican Republic and have invited the congregation to hear about their adventures this weekend. Please stop by the Mission table on the Courtyard and visit with Jenny Hurn to hear more about her ministry at universities in San Francisco.
