



A Summary of the Book of Ephesians

Eph 1 - **God is great**

VS 17: I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit^f of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.

Eph 2 - **You are saved because of God's grace**

VS 8: For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—

Eph 3 - **You are part of God's plan, don't be discouraged**

VS 16,17: I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being,¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.

Eph 4 - **Part of the plan is for you to grow and be worthy of what you can't earn**

VS 1,2: I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.² Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

Eph 5 - **Be careful how you live your life – in the light and out of darkness**

VS 18: Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit,

Specific instructions to family, masters, slaves: 5:21-6:9

Eph 6 - **Having done what you can do, put your reliance in God.**

VS 10, 11: Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.
